## Dear Our Lady of Victory Families,

Mark your calendars: GRANDPARENTS/SPECIAL FRIENDS DAY is on October 27 for grades K-4 from 8:45-10:45. This is a wonderful day that starts with 8:45am mass in church. Following mass, our grandparents/special friends are invited to join us in the Convocation Center for a musical performance. Mass begins at 8:45, and the concert is immediately following. Information came home two weeks ago. If you need a copy of the Grandparents/Special Friends Day RSVP form, please contact the school office.

Our October Caring and Sharing School Spirit Day is Friday, October 28. Information about this will come home in the Voice of Victory.

**REPORT CARDS:** Our First Quarter ends on Oct. 21. Report cards will come home on Oct. 28. Please sign the report card and return it to school as soon as possible.

**CONFERENCES:** Inside each report card will be a conference request form. If you would like to request a conference, please fill out the form and return it to school by Friday, November 4. We welcome any parents who feel that they need or would like a conference to come. If everything is going well, and you decide not to come in for conferences, please know that we do not think that you don't care about your children. ☺ We know that Victory families are involved in their children's education, and we don't view your lack of need for a conference as a lack of caring about your children.

For your planning, our conference day is November 21. We have an additional conference day on Friday, November 18 for junior high only. The junior high students do not have school on November 18. You will receive a letter from your child's teacher listing your conference time on or before November 11. If you request a conference and don't receive the conference time confirmation, please call the school office.

**ATTENTION EIGHTH GRADE PARENTS:** It's hard to believe that it's already time to talk about high school for our eighth graders. Whether this is your first time, your last time, or somewhere in the middle, preparing your child for high school is an exciting time. We are so blessed in Cincinnati to have so many wonderful high schools. Here are a few helpful hints:

- ✓ All students attending a Catholic high school need to take the High School Placement Test (HSPT) on Saturday, November 19. It is offered at the high schools. You have to register at the high school of your choice in order to take it there. If your child is on an ISP and will need special accommodations for the test, it is very important that you register as soon as possible and tell the high school when you register for the test. Most high schools can offer accommodations.
- ✓ Most of the Catholic high schools have Open Houses and/or special welcome evenings in October or November. These Open Houses are good ways to get acquainted with all the high school has to offer.
- ✓ Don't hesitate to call high schools with your questions. They are always willing to help.
- ✓ Often high schools change registration requirements and/or scholarship options from year to year. For example, I know that Seton has changed some of their scholarship options for this upcoming year. Please make sure that you take advantage of all of the opportunities.
- ✓ Each high school has its own registration and scholarship procedure. October is a good month to contact high schools and ask for their information for registration and/or scholarships. Often the deadlines are in October or November.
- ✓ If you have questions regarding financial assistance, this is also a good time to contact high schools about their procedures for applying for financial aid. High schools have different requirements and deadlines, and some are as early as the end of October.
- ✓ OUR DOOR IS ALWAYS OPEN. If you need help or want some additional information on any of the above information, please call. I am happy to help in any way that I can.

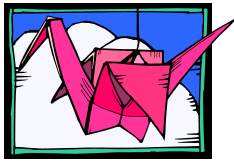

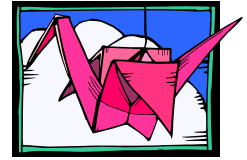


# OLV Origami Contest
